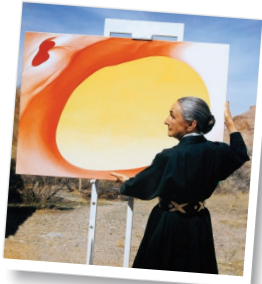


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# Santa Fe, New Mexico

### WED, JUN 19 2024

Rendezvous at the Drury Plaza Hotel. WWW will discuss the various flight options with you— guests can fly into either Albuquerque or Santa Fe airport.

The Drury is located right downtown within walking distance of restaurants, great shopping and some of the best museums in New Mexico. The Drury boasts large, comfy rooms with microwave and mini fridges in all rooms and a rooftop lounge ideal for our gatherings. Enjoy their complimentary breakfast buffet and evening beverages with hot food— this is where we'll regroup and share the day's stories before dinner!

### THURS, JUN 20 2024

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then we meet our long time guide and friend Jerry for an orientation and walk through town. The Plaza has a friendly vibe with fabulous museums, art

galleries and shops lining the perimeter of the grassy park. We begin with a brief introduction to the history of Santa Fe followed by a visit and tour of the Georgia O'Keefe Museum.

The Museum is the perfect introduction to Georgia's fascinating life and artwork. We enjoy a light welcome lunch together in town and then it's a gentle walk back to the hotel – past one of the best shoe shops in New Mexico!

### FRI, JUN 21 2024

Today is our 'Everything Georgia' day. We begin with a visit to Georgia's private home and studio, then continue to Ghost Ranch. Here we enjoy lunch followed by our tour led by a local expert who will bring the ranch's colourful history to life.

This is where Georgia spent time painting her ethereal landscapes—you won't have any trouble understanding why once you've visited the ranch. Time permitting, we will stop at a local artist's studio before returning to the hotel.

### SAT, JUN 22 2024

We begin the day at Museum Hill, home to four world class museums. One of our favorites is the Museum of International Folk Art - the largest collection of international folk art in the world. The quirky pieces and lively discourse provided by the docent will leave you smiling. We will visit the Museum of Indian Arts & Culture where we view southwest artifacts from ancestral to contemporary times. Enjoy a light lunch on your own outside at the Museum Hill café. This afternoon is free,



allowing time to visit the further explore museums on the hill and to wander through the outstanding museum boutiques.

**SUN, JUN 23 2024**

Today we're off for a full day tour to Chimayo and Taos by private coach. The drive is a harvest of colour – the earth tones of the adobe homes, the green fields awash in wild

flowers and the deep blue of New Mexico's blue skies. Scores of artists made their way to Taos in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century in search of the mystic and the primitive. Modernism arrived in 1917 with the heiress Mabel Dodge

Luhan who wanted more than anything to be a muse – by the time we arrive in Taos you'll have heard the story. We first visit the Taos Pueblo with its

multi-storied adobe buildings which have been continuously inhabited for over 1000 years. This UNESCO world heritage site sits on 99,000 acres of land at 7,200 feet.

Afterwards, a picnic lunch alongside the Rio Grande, then we are off to visit to the Millicent

Rogers Museum where the heiress' magnificent turquoise jewellery collection is housed, along with textiles, pottery &

basketry. On our route out of town we visit the historic Rancho de Taos church. Scores of builders and artisans sculpted this unique Adobe structure, with its massive buttresses and two front-facing bell towers.

A favourite subject for artists it was made famous by the photographs of Ansel Adams and the paintings of Georgia O'Keefe.

**MON, JUN 24 2024**

We have plans! Today we'll be making a private visit to one of Santa Fe's historic private homes. Timing for the day will determined by our hosts closer to the tour date– there will be some free time before we take in the Friday night Canyon Road Art Walk.

Beautifully preserved and restored Adobe and Territorial style homes line Canyon Road, most housing art galleries that range from works by old masters and traditional North American weaving, jewellery and ceramics to contemporary sculpture paintings. This is an easy amble, and you'll find cafes and restaurants to recharge your batteries should you need it. It's just plain fun exploring these galleries and meeting the artists along the way.

**TUES, JUN 25 2024**

Santa Fe Railyard District! This morning we walk to the Saturday Farmer's market, one of the oldest, largest and most successful markets in the country. This area is home to Site Santa Fe, a dynamic museum that presents innovative art in creative, engaging ways. You'll find several contemporary galleries, design shops and lots of restaurants for a casual lunch.
