Haida Tourism

Haida Tourism owns both Haida House and Ocean House, the two accommodations we will be staying at in Haida Gwaii. Haida Tourism is 100% Haida-owned. Their team is dedicated to offering an authentic Haida Gwaii experience, enhanced by regionally-inspired cuisine. Cultural preservation is vital to their community, and they are passionate about sharing their proud heritage and vibrant living culture with their guests and future generations.

Haida House - June 9-12 (3 nights)

Haida House is nestled along the banks of the serene Tlell River, surrounded by ancient forest and open sky. With its timeless and cozy log aesthetic, this is the perfect home base from which to start off on your Haida Gwaii adventure. They offer a 10 bedroom main lodge as well as oceanside cabins. The cabins feature a minibar kitchen, a great room with fireplace, flatscreen TV, covered hot tub and outdoor shower and wi-fi.

Guests who are sharing accommodations will be staying in the two-bedroom oceanside cabins. Each guest will have a private bedroom, with a shared washroom.

For those requesting single occupancy, there are two possible arrangements. *Note that Haida House cannot confirm what room type will be assigned until November.

1. A private bedroom within a shared cabin (with another solo traveler), including a shared washroom; or
2. A private room with an ensuite bathroom in the main lodge.



Ocean House - June 12-14 (2 nights)

Ocean House offers boutique accommodations overlooking a protected bay near the village of Old Massett. The peaceful and visually-stunning setting offers convenient access to Naikoon Provincial Park, as well as the many Haida arts and culture experiences available in Massett and the neighbouring communities. A dining room featuring gourmet tide-to-table cuisine, and a rejuvenating Haida-inspired spa, complete with treatment rooms, cedar sauna, steam room and fitness centre.

We will be staying in hotel rooms at this accommodation that feature two queen beds for the twin share guests and one queen bed for those with single occupancy.
